A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE LOCAL CLIMATE CHANGE ADAPTATION PLAN 2023 AND LCCAP 3 – YEAR PLAN

WHEREAS, In response to the urgency for action on climate change, the Philippines passed Republic Act No. 9729, also known as the “Climate Change Act of 2009” Section 2 of the law states that “it is the policy of the State to afford full protection and the advancement of the right of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology to fulfill human needs while maintaining the quality of the natural environment for current and future generation;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit is mandated to exercise their inherent powers such as police power, as well as share with national government the responsibility in the management and maintenance of ecological balance in their respective territorial jurisdiction as stated in Section 2a, 15, 3 I of Republic Act No. 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1990;

WHEREAS, R.A. No. 9729, as amended by R.A. 10174 provides that, LGU’s shall be frontline agencies in the formulation, planning and implementation of

Climate Change action plans in their respective areas, consistent with the provisions of R.A. 7160, the National Framework Strategy on Climate Change (NFSCC), and the National Climate Change Action Plan (NCCAP);


WHEREAS, The Local Climate Change Action Plan (LCCAP) is the action plan formulated by the LGUs to address climate concerns. The LCCAP focuses on both climate change adaptation and describes how LGUs plan to respond to climate change and mainstream such into development plans;
